

Benefits


- Backup copies of your SQL Objects
- The ability to revert to a previous point in time.
- Know exactly which objects have changed since last check-in.
- Compare conflicts to determine which should be committed.
- Audit history

SQL Source Control Benefits


- Connect to all version control systems GIT now supported
- Able to version data
- Ability to check in custom scripts to handle complicated changes (Migration Scripts)
- Rollback changes that haven't been committed
- Merge lines of code
- Participate in continuous integration





SQL Source Control Benefits

- GIT now supported

- Tie check-ins to work items in TFS, SVN, and GIT (<u>Documentation</u>)
- Work directly in Visual Studio if you prefer
- Filter out objects that should not be versioned (Love this!!)
- Filter out aspects of SQL Syntax (Love this more!!)


